- Collaboration with local schools and colleges introducing healthcare careers into the NHS

**Healthcare Support Worker**

- Minimum 5 GCSE's A-D including Maths and English or equivalent
- Completed Health Support Worker Apprenticeship
- Care Certificate
- Potential to undertake Higher Apprenticeship/Foundation Degree
- Can progress to therapy or nursing pathway

**Assistant Practitioner**

- Completed Higher Apprenticeship/Foundation Degree (Level 5 qualification)
- Care Certificate
- Therapy or Nursing pathway

**Nursing Associate**

- NMC registered role
- Trainee Nursing Associate Apprenticeship
- 24 month Level 5 training programme
- Future development from Assistant Practitioner into Nursing Associate Role

**Registered Nurse**

- NMC registered role
- Degree level Apprenticeship
- 24 month programme if completed Higher Apprenticeship/Foundation Degree
- 48 month programme to be developed

**Advanced Clinical Practitioner**

- Training to include Advanced Clinical Practitioner Standard, incorporating L7 Master's degree in Advanced Clinical Practice.
- Typical 36 month training duration



Further career development opportunities to specialist roles and pathways including Masters level apprenticeships with potential to progress to Senior Managers, Advanced Clinical Practitioners and Physicians Associates.
