Freedom of Information Request – 4365

Please can you provide me with the following information under the Freedom of Information Act.

1. How many "daily living aids" (eg walking sticks, and crutches) were issued to patients by the hospital (A & E, Fracture clinic or similar department) in the last financial year.

The total number of walking aids ordered was 4534.

1748 daily living aids were issued by A&E

111 daily living aids were issued directly from the Physiotherapy outpatient walking aids clinic.

The remaining were issued by Therapists within the acute hospital.

2. How many "daily living aids" (eg walking sticks, and crutches) were picked up or recycled by the hospital (or a company working for the hospital) in the last financial year.

We do not have a collection service and none of the aids are currently re-cycled to re-issue to patients. Currently the cost of re-certifying equipment before re-issue makes this unviable. However, a new scheme is currently being considered.

3. How much did the hospital spend on "daily living aids" (eg walking sticks, and crutches) in the last financial year.

The total spend on all walking aids was £54,202.89
