

**Freedom of Information Request – 4287**

I write under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to request the following information.

By 'treated/seen', requester means when the patient has been treated in entirety and discharged, so the measure of time from arrival to departure (which has a target of 4 hours).

For each individual calendar year in the period 2014 through to 2018 (Year to Date) inclusive, please breakdown how many children aged 15 and under attending the hospital's A&E department for mental health related issues, were treated/seen by a doctor within four hours, and how many waited longer than four hours to be treated. If possible, please give a breakdown of how long those waiting four+ hours were waiting, e.g. six, seven hours etc.

For each individual calendar year in the period 2014 through to 2018 (Year to Date) inclusive please breakdown how many children aged 16 and 17, attending the hospital's A&E department for mental health related issues, were treated/seen by a doctor within four hours, and how many waited longer than four hours to be treated.
