Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, Please tell me:

4. Please tell me the number of deaths caused by malnutrition as the underlying cause or contributing factor for the financial years, 2017, 2018, 2019.

We can confirm that the Trust may hold this information, however, we have estimated that the cost of complying with your request would exceed the appropriate limit as set out in the Freedom of Information and Data Protection (Appropriate Limit and Fees) Regulations 2004.

The limit set down by the regulations for public authorities is £450, which amounts to a maximum of 18 hours of search and retrieval time charged at £25 per hour, the hourly rate also specified in the regulations. We consider that it would take in excess of 18 hours to retrieve and extract the information as this would mean checking through individual documents for the information requested. Subsequently, it would cost more than £450, the limit specified in the regulations, to provide the information.

Under section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 we are therefore not obliged to provide the information that you have asked for unless the fee is paid and we will not be processing your request further unless we hear from you within 3 months.
