

TIA pathway

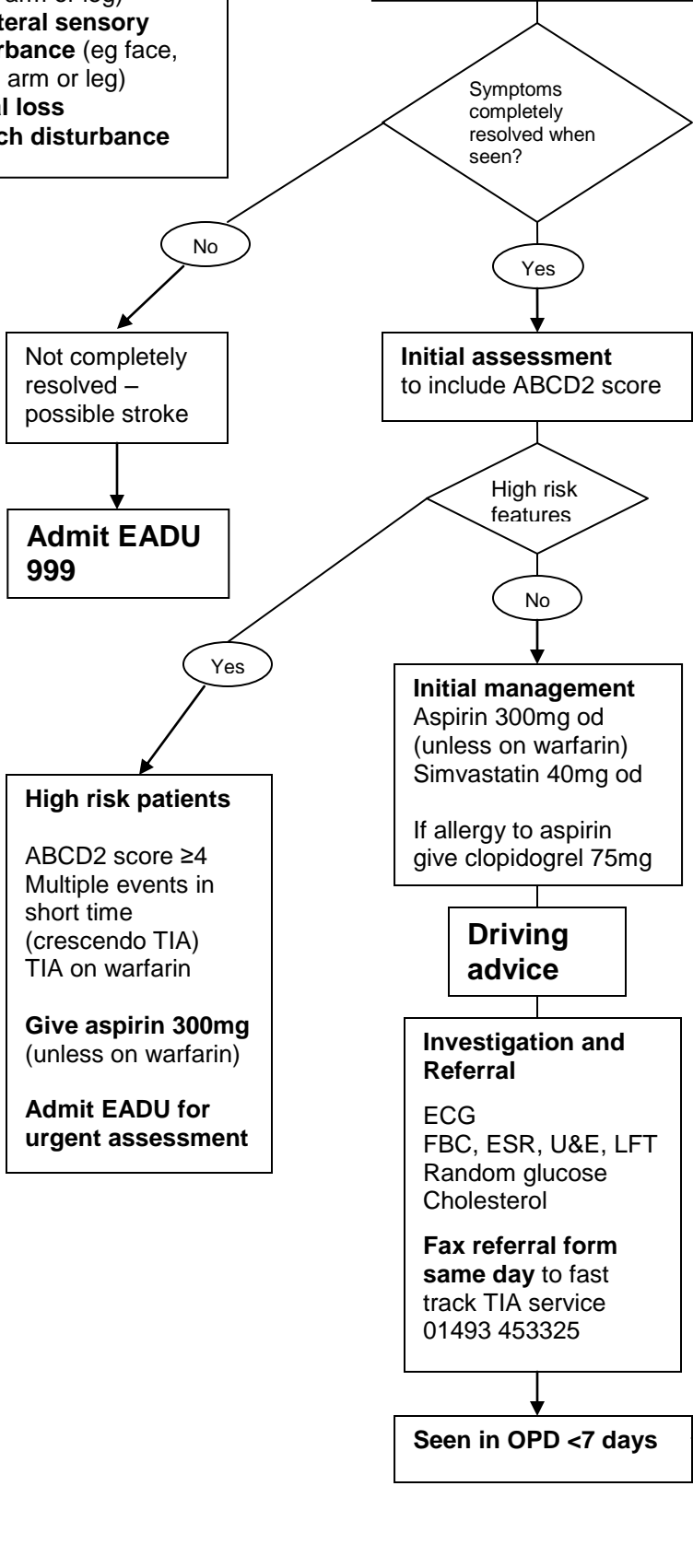
Transient symptoms likely to be TIA

- Unilateral weakness** (face, arm or leg)
- Unilateral sensory disturbance** (eg face, whole arm or leg)
- Visual loss**
- Speech disturbance**

Patient presents to GP or A&E with suspected TIA (symptoms lasting <24h)

Transient symptoms unlikely to be TIA

- Loss of consciousness
- Transient global amnesia
- Positive visual symptoms (eg flashing lights)



DVLA rules
Stop driving for minimum 1 month
