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Who can see the Neurology Nurse Practitioner?

Anyone who has a confirmed diagnosis of Parkinson's Disease, Multiple Sclerosis, Motor Neurone Disease, Epilepsy (not including NEAD).

Who can refer to the Neurology Nurse Practitioner?

Any health professional.

Where are clinics held?

In the Department of Medicine at the James Paget University Hospital.

What should I bring to my appointment in the Nurse Led Clinic?

It would be helpful if you could bring a list of medications with you and any questions you wish to ask about your condition.

What does the Neurology Nurse Practitioner do?

Works long side the Neurologists in providing expert advice to you, whether you are newly diagnosed or have had your condition for some time.

Manages a caseload of patients that are not routinely reviewed by the Neurologist.

Active in Research related to Neurological conditions that may enhance your care.

Advice on symptom management, support and guidance with the prescribing of appropriate medication as required, with a management plan if needed.

Provides support if you are admitted to hospital, offering advice on your specific needs including medication advice.
